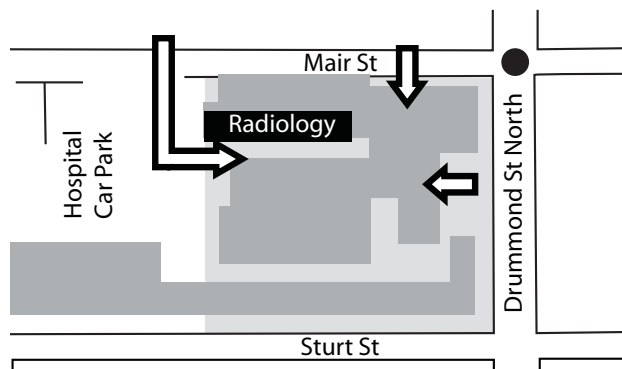

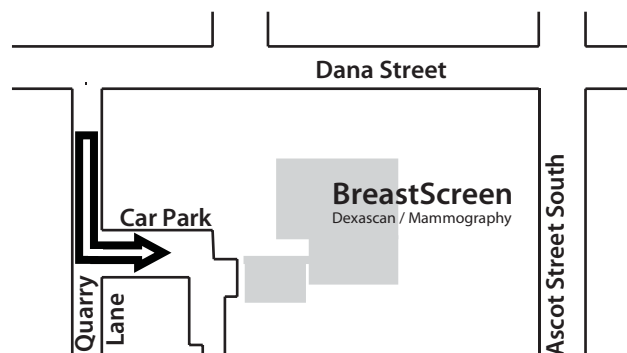

Preparation Guidelines and Patient Information

Ultrasound Pregnancy/Pelvis

Drink 1 litre of water 2 hours before your appointment and do not go to the toilet. Please arrive with a full bladder.

Renal Ultrasound

Fast for 4 hours. Please arrive with a full bladder. Drink 2-3 glasses of water (children 1-2 glasses) in the hour before the appointment.

Upper Abdomen Ultrasound

Fast (no food or drink) for 12 hours prior to the appointment.

Barium Meal/Swallow

Fast (no food or drink) for 12 hours prior to the appointment.

Barium Enema

Please contact the department on 5320 4270.

Intravenous Pyelogram (IVP)

Please contact the department on 5320 4270.

Barium Follow Through / Small Bowel Series

Fast for 6 hours prior to the appointment. This examination may take 3-4 hours.

MRI Examinations

Contact the MRI Department on (03) 5320 4311

CT Abdomen / Pelvis

Fast for 4 hours prior to the appointment. Arrive one hour prior to the examination time.

CT Brain

Fast (no food or drink) for 4 hours prior to the appointment.

CT Spine

No preparation required.

Nuclear Medicine

Please bring a list of your current medications. Restrictions apply for pregnant and breast feeding patients. Please contact us for further information.

Bone Scan - There will be 2 appointments over 4 hours.

Heart (Myocardial) Scan - Light breakfast only. No Tea, Coffee, Chocolate or Soft Drinks for 24 hours before your appointment. Cease some medications. This examination may take 3-4 hours. Please contact the department on 5320 4270

Gastric Emptying - Fast for 6 hours. This examination may take 2-3 hours.

Urea Breath Test - Fast for 6 hours. Cease some medications. Please contact the department on 5320 4270

Bone Densitometry / DexaScan - located at QE Centre - Breast Screen Facility. Please call (03) 5320 4270 for an appointment.

Mamography - located at QE Centre - Breast Screen Facility. Please call (03) 5320 4270 for an appointment.
